

One of our ministries, **Pathway Christian Academy**, was flooded. Fortunately, the staff and other volunteers had come down to the school the day after Matthew hit and prepared for the upcoming flood. We never expected it to be so bad. We honestly thought what we were doing was overkill.

When the waters receded, my husband and I came down to look at the school. We waded in knee deep water to get to the building. The water had gone out of the building except for a few spots. As I looked around, my heart was

broken. My beloved academy was in shambles. The waterline was at about 3 1/2 to 4 feet. As we went further, we did not know what we were going to find. My mind was racing as I thought of the ministry the Lord had allowed me to help build. It was not just the investment of the property we were all concerned about; it was the investment of time we had put into creating the best learning environment and materials for our students.

We were relieved to find we had saved the students' materials. We had also saved all records and irreplaceable

items. Many material things were lost, and it was heart rending to see the desks as well as other things ruined. However, it could have been so much worse.

The next day we had the entire staff meet at the school to sort through everything. We had a save pile, a maybe pile, and yes, a garbage pile. Unfortunately, the garbage pile was growing about as fast as the other two piles. The staff and many volunteers cleaned all of the save items and the maybe items with pine sol or bleach. We sorted everything in a day, and then we continued to tear out walls and carpets over the next few days. Then we spent a few days extracting water and cleaning and disinfecting everything. It was such a mess.

One of the pleasures we had was stopping to eat lunch under the canopy out front. There was a nice breeze blowing and the sun was shining on our backs. We were all talking and one of our staff members mentioned that she heard on the radio this morning that it was only nine more weeks until Christmas. I said nothing, but on the inside I was thinking plenty. "Who could be thinking about Christmas at a time like this?" Christmas is supposed to be a time of joy. It is supposed to be a happy season. It is supposed to smell like cinnamon and sugar cookies, not fish and rotten sewage. It is supposed to be beautiful and bright, not ugly and brown.

You see, I was looking around and allowing my circumstances to control my thoughts. I was not a happy camper. I was looking at all of the devastation and work in front of me. I thought, "This is no time for Christmas." Then, as I often do, I began to think. I felt convicted over the way I was feeling.



I was falling into that trap. All I was thinking about was what we do at Christmas instead of Who Christmas is about. Jesus was born in a smelly stable with animals, visited by shepherds, and wrapped in swaddling clothes. How could I possibly feel sorry for myself? Christmas is about His birthday. There is nothing wrong with having other festivities at Christmas, but the problem comes when that is what Christmas is about to us. Christmas is about our Saviour's birth. It is about new life. It is about the new life our Lord came to give us on this special day. He is the Spirit that lives within!

There is new life at the academy, too. The first time I felt it was when I walked through and realized it smelled clean again. As I write this article, I can smell the paint going on the walls.

Soon, we will be getting new carpet. By the time you read this, we will be in our building. The academy received new life, and so can you. When you feel broken and torn, Jesus can give you life. He is there to pick up the pieces and allow you to start over.

Christmas is about the new life Jesus came to offer us one special day. Let's not allow the things of this world to cloud our vision and get us sidetracked from the specialness of Christmas. Let's make it all about Christ! Let Him give you new life!


